RULES

The Border Battle Series was created to have a bunch of fun, cover some new trail and meet and race with new people. As such, unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated in any way, shape or form. Intentional course cutting or altercations with other riders, race officials or volunteers will result in disqualification from **ALL** Border Battle XC Challenge events.

That said, riders will be extended every courtesy in protesting any scoring or rules discrepancies and are encouraged to do so under the guidelines of the AMA rulebook.

Round one and round three will use the AMA District 23 class structure as shown at the end of this document.

Round two will utilize the WIXC class structure as shown at the end of this document.

All riders competing in round one or round three will be required to have a current AMA membership.

All riders competing in a round one or round three will be required to have a District 23 membership. A one-day membership can be printed from the link below or purchased on site for \$10. Riders can purchase one-day memberships for each round and qualify for series awards but will not be eligible for District 23 year-end awards

All riders competing in round two will be required to have a WIXC Membership. Single day membership is \$15 and includes a barcode for scoring. Annual memberships are \$30 and can be upgraded for \$15 any time a rider competes in a second WIXC event.

Scoring at rounds one and three will be electronic via Moto-Tally. All riders will be required to have a current Moto-Tally transponder. Transponders will be available on site for \$15. WIXC members will be provided with a transponder at no charge with proof of membership.

BORDER BATTLE XC SERIES POINTS

Riders from ALL CLASSES are eligible to win the Grand Prize Timbersled snow bike kit.

Riders must compete in all three rounds to be eligible for year-end awards. Worker points **DO NOT** count towards series points/awards.

Round one and round three will start one class at a time, every 60 seconds. Some "like" classes may be combined on the starting line. Example: Sr. B/Super Sr. B or B Masters/Sportsman 2

Round two will start in mass waves - 1. A class, 2. B class, 3. Age classes, 4. C class. Youth classes will have there own race time and race course. Race times will be 9am for 65, 85 and Women's, 10AM all Bikes with 1 minute between rows, +50 class gets pulled off at 1.5 hours and the rest of the classes are 2 hours.

Race day points will be awarded per AMA/WIXC scoring 30-25-21-18-16-15-15, etc.

SERIES points will be awarded same as race day points, plus 1 bonus point for each rider who starts in your class that day. Example - first place in a class with 12 riders on the starting line - 30 + 12 = 42 series points.

ALL riders must declare a specific class from the district 23 list for year end awards. THIS DESIGNATION WILL BE USED TO AWARD SERIES POINTS. IF YOU FINISH 5TH IN THE "A" CLASS AT THE WIXC EVENT BUT ARE THE TOP RIDER with a designation of "A" 200, YOU WILL STILL RECEIVE 30 SERIES POINTS PLUS RIDER BONUS POINTS.

WIXC Rider classification in series may be subject to review of WIXC officials.

The GRAND PRIZE Polaris Timbersled Snow Bike kit will be awarded to the rider with the highest series point total. Riders from ALL CLASSES are eligible to win the Grand Prize. In the event of a tie, the following system will be used as a tie-breaker:

- 1.Most wins
- 2.Best finish at round 3
- 3. Most rider bonus points
- 4. Highest class designation AA, A, B, Junior, C, Women, Premier, PeeWee, Girls, Macro, Micro

FUEL STOPS

Fuel stops at rounds one and three must take place in the designated pit lane located near the pit parking area.

AA riders will have a designated pit area/lane at rounds one and three. Each AA rider must take this **Sunoco Race Fuel** pit lane at least one time during their race. Riders do not have to take fuel, but are required to stop at an observation checkpoint before re-entering the main racing line. Not pitting prior to the completion of your last scored lap will result in a DQ.

The AA pit area at rounds one and three will be in the **Sunoco Race Fuel** pit lane location near vendor row. Riders and teams are encouraged to display sponsor canopies, banners and/ or flags within their $15' \times 50'$ pit box.

AA riders will enter the staging area at rounds one and three from their pit lane and be introduced as they make their way to the starting line. AA intros will allow several hundred yards of "hot" track time.
